HOW TO TALK TO GIRLS AT PARTIES

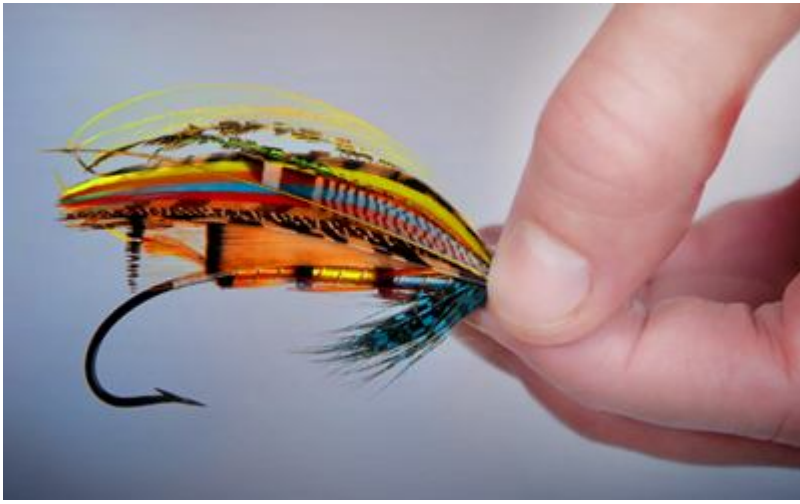
